



Federal Reserve Bank Payment Update

Description:

This session will provide an update on current and future opportunities for financial institutions to take advantage of the Federal Reserve's financial services. Among the services discussed will be FedACH services such as Risk Management, FedEDI Plus, Same-Day FedACH, and international ACH transactions (IATs) in general and, more specifically, through the Federal Reserve's FedGlobal suite of services. We will also briefly discuss other non-ACH "hot topics" in Federal Reserve financial services, such as FedReceipt Plus for Returns (electronic delivery of chargebacks).
